

PATIENCE BHOBO was the first woman employed at Streetwires. She began as the housekeeper but soon started shaping and beading wire with the other artists and then went on to work in dispatch. She remains one of the few women at Streetwires who could shape as well as bead. Tragically, she died in 2003 from HIV related complications during childbirth. She is remembered still with great affection and we chose to honour her memory by giving her name to our cause ribbon collection.
